

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What types of memberships do you have?

- **Qualification for Membership**
The members of the Corporation shall be citizens of the United States of America who have attained the age of eighteen (18) years, are a member of the National Rifle Association (one per household), and complied with all other qualifications and criteria for membership.
- **General Membership:**
Any person who makes proper application and qualifies.
- **Armed Forces Members:**
Any club member who is deployed overseas and whose membership lapses during his deployment will have his/her membership extended for one year when he/she returns home.
- **Family Membership:**
Person and his or her spouse, both persons entering under a family membership shall enjoy a full general membership in the Corporation.
- **Senior Membership:**
Any Corporate member of five (5) consecutive years directly preceding his sixty-fifth (65th) birthday, who conforms to all other qualifications for membership.

Q. How do I get qualified on the 200-yard range?

- In the club house next to the guest sign in is a signup sheet for the 200 yard range. Enter your name and phone number. You will receive a call and be instructed to report for qualification. You will have to hit an 8.5 x 11 target on the 100 yard 5 times and then you will go to the 200 yard range where you need 3 hits on the same size target. You will then be qualified to use the 200 yard range and issued a badge that must be worn when using it.

Q. When can I shoot trap?

- Trap shoots are held Sunday mornings 10am-12pm (or until we run out of ammo).

Q. What is required when I bring a guest?

- In the club house you must sign in legibly printing your name and your guest(s) name(s). Upon entering the range area, you are responsible for your guest's safety and compliance with safety procedures and club rules. Violation of safety or club rules will be your responsibility and not your guest's.

Q. Are family members who are also club members required to join the NRA?

- No, the club requires only one active NRA membership per household. GOAL is optional for the primary and other family members.

Q. How do I report observed safety and rule violations?

- In the club house in the same location as guest sign in you will find an **Incident Report Form** ([or click here to download](#)). Complete the form (accurate location,

date and time are required). Put the completed form in the mailbox located on the door. If you do not feel comfortable signing the form, submit any way and we will take it from there.

Q. How do I qualify for the senior reduced rate renewal?

- You must be a member for five years **AND** be 65 years of age or older.
